CJW – Chippenham Campus

The pharmacy is on the 4th floor. Elevator code (if needed): 7101*

- 1) Elevator between Chest Pain and Intermediate: Exit the back of the elevator on the 4th floor, make a right then make another right at the end of the hall. You will pass the Nuclear Med/Stress Lab waiting area which is bordered by planters on your right-hand side. Continue past the waiting area and the Pharmacy Department is on the right-hand side before you come to the end of the hall.
- 2) Elevator between Critical and Chest Pain: Take the elevator to the 4th floor, make a left turn, then a right turn at the end of the hall. You will pass the Nuclear Med/Stress Lab waiting area which is bordered by planters on your right-hand side. Continue past the waiting area and the Pharmacy Department is on the right-hand side before you come to the end of the hall.

CJW – Johnston-Willis Campus

Exit the ED at the back of the department. Turn left. Go down the first hallway on your right (there should be two elevators). The pharmacy is on your left hand side past the windows. Press the doorbell to be let in.

Halifax Regional Medical Center

Exit the ED through the double doors into the lobby hall. Turn left, then take a right past the gift shop. There will be 2 elevators there. Take the elevator to the second floor. Upon exiting the elevator, turn left. The pharmacy will be at the end of the hallway.

John Randolph Medical Center

Take the hallway past the EMS nourishment room. Go out the door and take the elevator to B-level. Make a right out of the elevator and travel down the hall. Pharmacy is on the left.

Lynchburg General

Walk thru the ED and exit on the hospital side. Once in the hallway, take the first hallway to the right and the pharmacy window is right there. Pick up the purple phone to connect to pharmacy staff.

Memorial Regional Medical Center

Retrieve “EMS Proximity Security Card” from Charge Nurse. Exit the ED into the patient waiting room hallway and turn left. Travel down the hallway, turn right, and go towards the cafeteria hallway. Take the elevators ahead to the ground floor (“G” button). Exit the elevator and turn to your immediate right. The pharmacy will be the second door on your right. Use intercom system to notify pharmacy staff that you need to exchange a drug kit.

McGuire VA Medical Center

Exit the ED through the double doors in the back and turn left. Take the first hallway on your right, and then go left where the sign says “Blood Lab →.” The in-patient pharmacy will be on your right; ring the doorbell to be let through the double doors and wait for a pharmacy staff member to let you through the next set of doors into the pharmacy.

Richmond Community Hospital

Exit the ED through the waiting room and follow the hallway past endoscopy. Take the first hallway on your right and go through the main lobby. Turn left at the cafeteria. The pharmacy will be on the right hand side of this hallway.

Sentara Obici

Exit the ED by room 7 and turn right. Continue down the hallway, turning left at the radiology waiting room. You will pass a bank of elevators on your right; the pharmacy window is on the right hand side just past these elevators.

Sentara Williamsburg

Leave ED via back entrance (opposite ambulance entrance) – you will need badge access to leave. Take an immediate left (do not go straight through radiology) and then a right along back hall. Take first right and then a left to access the employee elevators. Take a right when leaving the elevator, then first right and keep straight until you reach the double doors. There is a phone on the left at the double doors. This will ring to the pharmacy and we will come and let them into the back hallway.

Southside Community Hospital

Exit the ED at the back of the department. Follow this hallway and do not go through any additional sets of doors. When you get to the intersection with a glass-enclosed desk, keep right. Continue down this hallway until you get to the lobby where there is a reception desk. The elevators are at the back of this lobby. Take the elevator down to the ground floor and the pharmacy will be to the left as you exit the elevator. Press the buzzer to be let in.

Southside Regional Medical Center

Exit the ED through the double doors across from the EMS liason’s office (just inside the ambulance entrance). Turn left, then take your first right. The pharmacy will be on your right. Ring the buzzer to be let inside.

St. Francis Medical Center

Exit out of the rear double doors of the ED (between Rooms 8 & 9). Enter back hallway and turn right. Proceed through double doors into hallway. Turn left and proceed through the double doors, pass through Radiology/Out-Patient Registration into the lobby area. To your left are two elevators. There is a door to the left of the elevators which will take you to the stairwell. You may use either the elevator or steps, proceed to the ground floor. At the bottom of the stairs is a secure door with a keypad to enter the passcode. The passcode is the same as the ED door code. Elevators rear doors will open. You may use either method. As you go through the doors of the stairwell or elevator, turn right. Proceed a short distance and turn right again. The Pharmacy is on your left. To return to the ED, reverse these directions. The passcode to return to the ED double doors is the same as the ED door code.

St. Mary’s Hospital

Exit the ED through the EMS entrance and turn left. Turn right into the first elevator bank on your right, then take the hallway to your left around the corner (it gets a little tight back here!) to a door. Take this staircase down one flight and exit the stairwell. Follow the wall to your right and take the first hallway to your right. The pharmacy will be about midway down this hallway on your left; press the buzzer to be let inside and wait at the desk for a pharmacy staff member.

VCU Community Memorial Hospital

Exit the ED near the EMS room and turn left. Continue down this hallway until it stops at a radiology room, then turn right. Follow this hallway until it ends, then turn right. Make an immediate left; the pharmacy will be on your right.

VCU Medical Center

When you exit the EMS work room, turn left, then enter the first door on the right (door appears locked but it is not), this will bring you to the Service elevators. Go to the Basement. When you get off the elevator there is a door with a speaker; that is the Pharmacy, where you need to be. After exchanging your drug box, get back on the Service elevators and go to the Ground floor. This will bring you back to the ER.
